- 4. Students will be proficient (Mastery or above) on state assessments in English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies in Grades 3–8.
- 5. Students will be proficient (Mastery or Excellent) on End-of-Course Exams in English I/II/ III, Algebra I, Geometry, Biology, and U.S. History.
- 6. Students will be proficient on ACT (composite score of 21 or higher) and/or Work Keys (composite score of Gold or higher).
- 7. Ninety percent (90%) of students will graduate on time.
- 8. Students will enroll in post-secondary education or graduate workforce-ready with college credit and/or Industry Based Credentials (IBC).
