2016-2017 KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

Kindergarten registration will occur on February 18, 2016, and February 19, 2016, at each public school in the parents' domicile area, and will continue at each school until May 9, 2016. After May 9th, registration will continue throughout the summer at Terrebonne Parish School Board Office. **Children must attend the school in the district where their parents or legal guardians live. For registrations, parents should bring proof of residency, immunization record, birth certificate, and social security card.** If your child is currently registered and attending Terrebonne Parish School District's Pre-K Program, they DO NOT have to be reregistered. These students will automatically be enrolled.

SPRING 2016 STATE TESTING

The Louisiana Department of Education has made a few adjustments in our state assessments for the 2015-2016 school year. For Grades 3–8, the testing window has been shortened to one testing week. This year's paper-based assessments for Grades 3–8 Math, English Language Arts, and Science will occur on April 25–29, 2016. Students will participate in a Social Studies Field-Test for Grades 3–8 during the week of May 9–13, 2016.

In Grades 8–9, the EXPLORE test has been eliminated. There are no other changes in our High School State Assessments.
